You'll have the opportunity to sample his BBQ at the event as well and we can tell you, you're in for a treat!

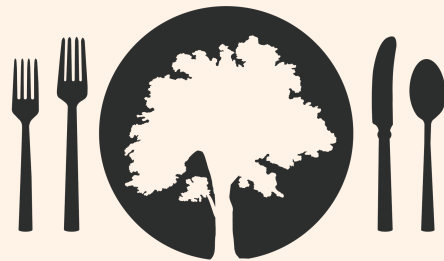
